I love the logic of children! There is no doubt that what they are concluding makes sense based on the information they have, but we know they need understanding and experience!

That is what we will do on Sunday mornings beginning next week. We will provide some basic information that will allow us to teach those who are new to Christianity or young in Christianity. Some of our number need to go over the basics again, some haven't really heard the basics in the first place!

Hebrews 5:12-14 *For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the first principles of the oracles of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid food. For everyone who partakes only of milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe. But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, that is, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.*

Notice how the author describes a person becomes mature in the word: "by reason of use!" The NIV says, "who by constant use have trained themselves..." The materials we are going to study are not simply for satisfying curiosity. These materials will be for use, for practicing, and for exercising what has been taught.
