

The End!

Most stories we read come to a concise ending. "...and they lived happily ever after. The End." None of them, however, tell you the end before it happens! They want you to wait to see it or read it. I have read stories where they told something thrilling that would happen close to then end, but they did not tell me what the actual end was!

All throughout the Bible, it is a story told with "the end" in mind. God has always wanted us to know the ending, because He wants us to know that the ending includes us! Not us today specifically, but us, who are humans. Once Adam and Eve took that fatal bite, He let them know what was going to happen.

Genesis 3:15 *And I will put enmity Between you (the serpent) and the woman (Eve), And between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, And you shall bruise His heel."*

Notice how "Seed" is capitalized! And notice even more importantly that the pronoun referring to "Seed" is singular and masculine. If you don't understand that grammar stuff, it simply means the "Seed" is Christ Jesus (**Galatians 3:16**)

So, what does THAT mean in reference to the "end?" It means all along from even BEFORE the garden, BEFORE the man and the woman, and even BEFORE the world was created, God wanted us to be with Him! He did not exactly detail HOW this would happen, but He did want us to know it *was going to happen!*

Only when Jesus resurrected from the grave did we begin to understand HE was involved in the plan, that HE, in fact, WAS the plan! He died, He came back to life so that we could receive "*the **END** of our faith—the salvation of our souls!*" **1 Peter 1:7**
